

We hope you are looking forward to half term. We certainly are because we can't wait to relax and read some great books. It would be fantastic if you could make time every day to do the same.




Avocado baby By John Burningham

Weedy parents have another baby and worry it's going to be as weak as they are. One day they feed it avocado and there are amazing results.




Flat Stanley (series) By Jeff Brown

'He felt a curious tingling in his hands and feet. He felt his nose becoming cold and wet, his ears becoming flappy.'




Operation Gadgetman! By Malorie Blackman.
