How this will be sustained:

- Continue to use a skilled PE teacher to teach high quality PE sessions to increase confidence.
- Continue to work with providers such as AFC Wimbledon to promote further opportunities.
- Continue to use coaches at play and lunch time and up skill staff.
- Continue to have sports leaders and team teach alongside teachers.

CPD Using Southfields Academy facilities and resources for current PE teacher to be able to stay fully trained and up to knowledge with best PE practice.	£600	PE teacher to attend all meetings and CPD with SGO.
Swimming - upskilling two more members of staff to teach swimming across the school.	£1000	Two members of staff to be fully trained in life saving and level 2 swimming safety and teaching award.

Extra Curricular: Sports day - providing more colour coordinated equipment eg- vortex's. To improve the confidence and expertise in staff to deliver good quality PE in a range of topics.
Internal Sports Competitions: The use of a coach and PE teacher within school.	£7795	To ensure high quality PE sessions are delivered throughout the school.

Internal Top Up Swimming Sessions: Year 6 booster sessions and SEN swimming sessions. Facilities paid for, maintenance of pool and swimming teachers.	£3500	Allowing Year 6 to have booster sessions to help swim 25m. SEN children to receive extra sessions for sensory and to help up-skill their swimming performance.
Active Travel: Providing Transport for children to attend school .	£500	Continue to use a range of transport to help specific families access the school on time.
