### 2014-2015 Progress Report

#### Use to Date

Sports Funding allocated by the Government has been used to help:

- Fund the salary costs of our specialist sports coach who works with classes throughout KS2. Each class goes over to Southfields Academy once a week.
- Fund the services of an additional swimming coach
- Provide equipment and resources

#### Monitoring

The Senior Leadership Team and PE/Sports Subject Leader regularly review the impact of sports funding throughout the term and monitor its impact on our pupils. We insist that our teachers team-teach alongside the sports specialist coach in order to develop their teaching skills in PE and Games. Teachers monitor pupil progress using PE baseline assessments which are completed at the beginning and end of each term. One of the aims this term is to target children who are not participating in sport regularly enough and to provide more opportunities for swimming, once both Swimming pools are up and running.

#### Impact

Our pupils show a great deal of enthusiasm and enjoyment for Sports and PE. As a school we promote a healthy lifestyle in children from an early age. We had Chelsea Football come in to work with us in promoting this aspect into children's lives. We have introduced our pupils with a variety of clubs for them to benefit from. Participation numbers are encouraging and many clubs are fully booked this term. These numbers helped us to gain the Bronze Award from the Sainsbury Games. The impact of the sports funding is evident in the positive feedback received by the pupils, staff and parents. We did a children's survey and found the results from this to be very positive and children's attitudes towards PE/Sports and a healthy lifestyle have changed. The impact can also be seen by the amount of children participating successfully in local borough sporting competitions. They have really enjoyed representing Riversdale at these events.
