Jonah  - Ran away because he was scared. - Was swallowed by a big fish.	 Our names make us special. What we like makes us special. What we can do makes us special. We are different now from when we were babies. We have grown and can do more.  Lots of stories tell us about how things can change.		
Theseus  Was a mythical Greek hero.	 The Ugly Duckling grew into a beautiful swan.  Theseus' ship changed because all the parts were replaced one by one. Jonah was still the same person after he changed his mind. Since the start of Year 1 we will have changed in lots of ways.
